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Conditions and rules of the admission procedure to the second-level study programme Precision Agriculture and Forestry at the Faculty of Engineering, Slovak University of Agriculture in Nitra, for the academic year 2026/2027.

BASIC CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO STUDY

The basic conditions for admission to the second-level study programme are as follows:

Completion of higher education at the first level (bachelor's degree) or second level (master's degree); in addition, the total number of ECTS credits obtained in the previous higher education, by which the applicant has acquired the degree, together with the number of credits required for the proper completion of the second-level study programme to which the applicant is applying, must be at least 300 credits.

FURTHER CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO STUDY

Further conditions for admission to the second-level study programme:

The applicant may indicate only one study programme on a single application form from among the study programmes offered for the academic year 2026/2027.

INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

International applicants must obtain a recognition statement via the following link: <https://uznavanie.minedu.sk/recognition-statement/> in the section "Recognition clause of the level of education".

International applicants (with the exception of applicants from the Czech Republic and applicants who passed the school-leaving examination in the Slovak language) who apply for a study programme provided in the Slovak language at the Slovak University of Agriculture in Nitra are required to take an online test and an online oral interview aimed at assessing their Slovak language proficiency. The testing is organised by the SPU Language Centre in Nitra (<https://cj.uniag.sk/sk/domov/>) on two dates, about which the applicants will be informed in advance.

After completing the language examination, the applicant will receive a certificate stating the overall result of the online test and the online interview, indicating the language level in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The test and the certificate are subject to a fee of 30 €. If the applicant's language proficiency level is lower than A1, the applicant will not be admitted to study.

If the applicant's language proficiency level is A1, the applicant fulfils one of the admission conditions; however, they will be required to complete a 30-hour paid Slovak language course organised by the SPU Language Centre in Nitra (course fee: 120 €). The course will take place from 24 August 2026 to 4 September 2026. Upon completion of the course, the applicant will receive a certificate of attendance. If the applicant's language proficiency level is A2 or higher, the applicant fulfils one of the admission conditions.

GENERAL INFORMATION ON THE ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Applicants to the study programme *Precision Agriculture and Forestry* who have successfully completed bachelor's studies will be admitted on the basis of their academic performance achieved at the first level of higher education and the results obtained in the state examination.

Applicants to the study programme *Precision Agriculture and Forestry* will be ranked in a list according to the points obtained under the admission criteria, whereby a minimum of 5 points from the criteria for the evaluation of applicants for second-level study is required for admission to the second level of study.

By adding the points for the grade point average, the result of the state examination and any participation in the Student Scientific Conference (ŠVK), a final points score is obtained, on the basis of which the ranking of applicants for second-level study will be compiled within each study programme.
